Then there was Technical Session 1 on Financing, Marketing and Capability Building to accelerate competitiveness. The two week long orientation programme was organized to help the students in their transition to be global managers. The dignitaries present for the session motivated the students and wished them success in their future endeavor.



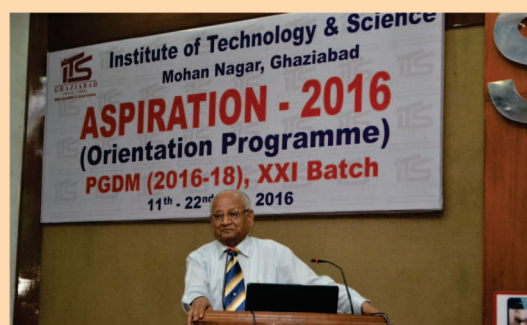
**Mind & Memory session by Dr. B.K. Chandera Shekhar, President of SIGFA Solutions
